

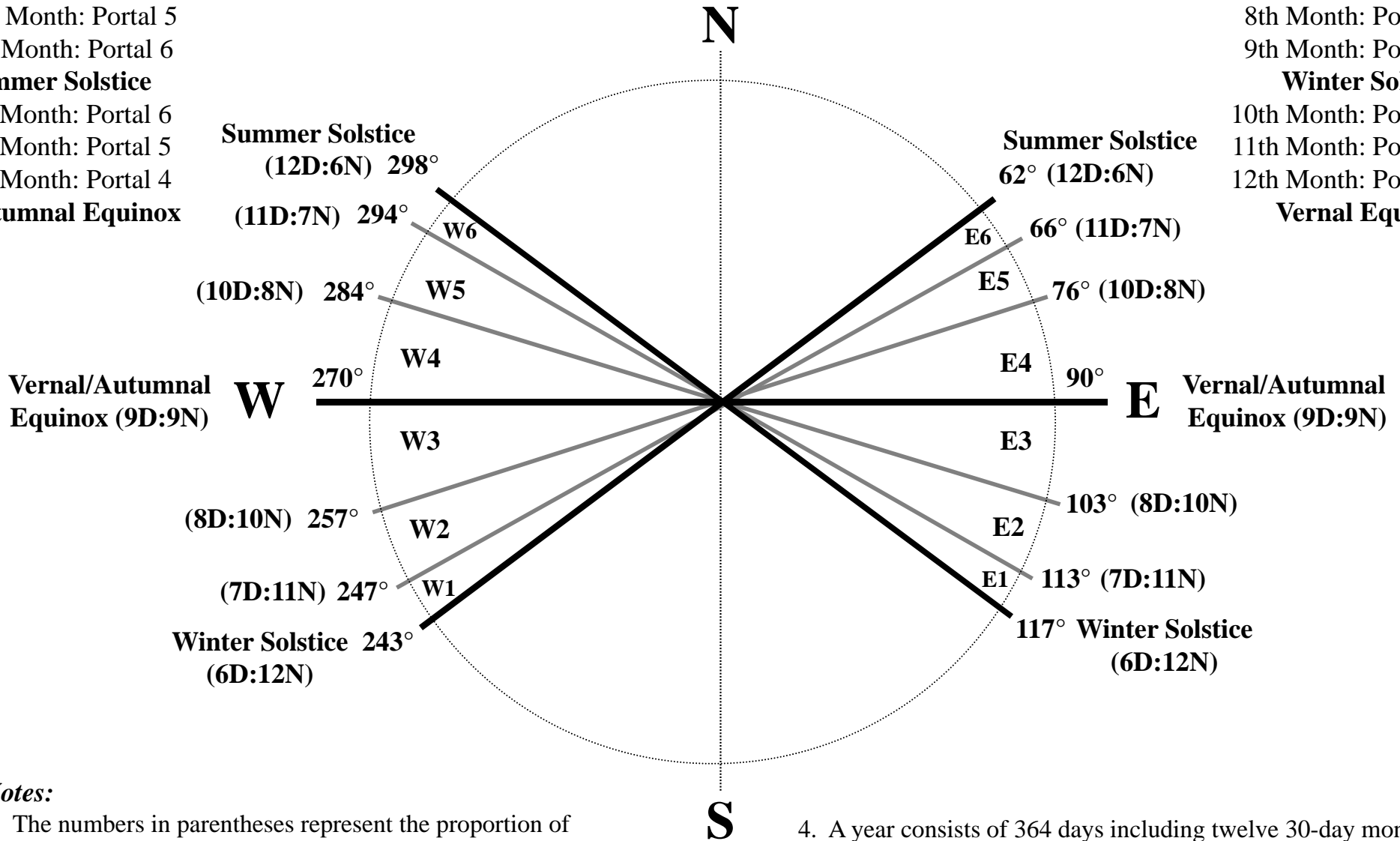

Notes:

1. The numbers in parentheses represent the proportion of (D)ay to (N)ight at the boundary of the designated portal.
2. The sun rises in the eastern portals and sets in the western.
3. This arrangement is applicable north of the equator.
4. A year consists of 364 days including twelve 30-day months plus four intercalary days to account for the equinoxes and solstices.
5. The compass points were estimated based on Jerusalem (not measured to scale).
